HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that the pensionary benefits for which the petitioner was entitled for have not been released despite the fact that petitioner has retired on 30.09.2010.

Today, a short affidavit has been filed on behalf of the respondents, wherein it has been stated that all the pensionary benefits to the petitioner stand released as far back as in December, 2017.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same but prays that as the petitioner retired from service on attaining the age

of superannuation on 30.09.2010, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of interest and, therefore, the petitioner be given liberty to file an appropriate representation with the respondents seeking the same and direction be issued to the respondents to decide the said representation expeditiously.

Counsel for the respondents states that in case any such representation is received from the petitioner seeking interest, the same will be decided in view of the settled principles of law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in the case of **A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab 1997(3) SCT 468** by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Counsel for the petitioner states that she does not wish to press the present writ petition any further.

The writ petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
