None has appeared for the petitioner as the Bar is still abstaining from work today.

However, a perusal of the petition shows that by way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks that a direction be issued to respondents no.4 and 5 to arrest the remaining accused persons in FIR no.100, dated 19.06.2019, registered at Police Station Punjab Agriculture University, Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 325, 341, 506 and 34 of the IPC.

He also seeks a direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to provide him security as he apprehends danger to his life at the hands of those not arrested.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is shown to have made representations to the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana and the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, i.e. respondents no.2 and 4 respectively, copies of which have been annexed as Annexure P-1 (colly) with the petition.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of what is contended in the petition, this petition is disposed of with a direction to

respondents no.2 and 4 to hear the petitioner and thereafter to take a decision on his grievances, as per law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
