Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.10 dated 09.01.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 201, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Lines Sonapat, District Sonapat.

As per allegation, certain persons attacked first informant and caused firearm injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is similar to that of Neeraj who has been released on bail vide

order dated 26.08.2019 in CRM-M-33503-2019.

Petitioner is in custody since 15.02.2019. Investigations are complete, challan has been presented. Prosecution intends to examine as many as 31 witnesses.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the conclusion of the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
