Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that in view of the settled principle of law laid down by this Court in **CWP No. 10806 of 2006 titled as Prem Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 20.07.2006** wherein, it has been held that no writ petition is maintainable against a cooperative sugar mill in view of the decision rendered in **General Manager, Kisan Sahkari Chini Mills Ltd. Sultanpur U.P. vs. Satrughan Nishad and others, AIR 2003 SC 4531** as well as against the Punjab State Cooperative Bank in view of the decision rendered by this Court in **CWP No.6776 of 1999 titled as Ranjit Singh Vs. The Registrar, Cooperative Societies, decided on 13.08.2010.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the appropriate authority under the Cooperative Societies Act, 1961.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

It is made clear that as the petitioner was before this Court pursuing this remedy, in case the petitioner files a petition before the authority under the Cooperative Societies Act 1961, the same will be decided on merits.
