Petitioner-Vishal has filed this petition for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.58 dated 26.04.2019, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Sections 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sarangpur, Chandigarh. Petitioner is in custody since his arrest on 26.04.2019.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The prosecution case is that during patrolling by police party, 5 grams heroin was recovered from the petitioner's possession.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer and has apprised the Court that out of total 12 prosecution witnesses, only 02 witnesses remain to be examined and the case is fixed for 22.11.2019. Learned State counsel has produced the custody certificate of the petitioner which reveals

that 11 other cases are pending against the petitioner and in 34 cases he had been convicted.

Considering the advanced stage of the trial and the fact that the petitioner is already convicted in 34 other cases, this Court does not find any reason to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Consequently, petition is dismissed at this stage.
