On 06.09.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No225, dated 27.11.2018, registered under Sections 307/324/323/427/341/148/149/506 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Islamabad, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the role attributed to the petitioner is that he exhorted other accused to attack on the injured. As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner has not caused any injury to anyone.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Tarsem Singh, has submitted that he is not in a position to controvert the submission of learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is

directed to join investigation.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 30.10.2019. ”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurvail Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, order dated 06.09.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
