

**502 FAO NO.4173 OF 2011
SMT. NISHA & ANR. V/S OM PARKASH & ORS.**

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the parties, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.2,60,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants and respondent No.2, in full and final settlement of the claim. As per statement of learned counsel for the appellants as well as the learned counsel for respondent No.2, 90% of the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Smt. Nisha Wd/o Shri Balwan Singh for and on behalf of herself and her minor son and remaining 10% of the enhanced amount be paid to respondent No.2-Smt. Bhateri Devi, mother of the deceased-Shri Balwan Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two cheques; one in the sum of Rs.2,34,000/- (Rupees Two Lac Thirty Four Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Smt. Nisha Wd/o Shri Balwan Singh and the other in the sum of Rs.26,000/- (Twenty Six Thousand Only) favouring respondent No.2-Smt. Bhateri Devi, mother of the deceased-Shri Balwan Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.05.2019. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel as well as counsel for respondent No.2 may collect their respective cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
