HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

As per the averments made in the writ petition, petitioner worked on daily wage basis from 05.05.1978 till 26.01.1994 after which his services were regularized on 27.01.1994.

As per the averments made in the writ petition, petitioner superannuated on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.04.2014, but the service, which he had rendered from 05.05.1978 till 26.01.1994, has not been taken into consideration as a qualifying service for the grant of pensionary benefits. The reliance has been placed by the petitioner on the order passed by a Full Bench of this Court in '**Kesar Chand Vs. State of Punjab and others**', AIR 1988 Punjab 265.

From the averments, it transpires that for the relief, which has been sought in the present writ petition, petitioner has submitted a

representation dated 08.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents.

Interest of justice will be served, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case and entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim made in the writ petition/representation, the respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 08.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of
