This petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 4 to take the FIR No.249 dated 11.12.2012 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur to its logical end as the decision was taken to present the challan as noticed by this Court in the order dated 28.02.2019. Alternatively, it is prayed that respondent No.3 be directed to provide the adequate security for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from the hands of private respondents who are extending threats.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute this fact that he was neither author of the FIR nor a witness but is pursuing this case as the record pertaining to the government land has been forged and fabricated.

The attention of the Court is invited to the order dated 28.02.2019 to contend

that his previous petition bearing No.CRM-M-13957-2017 was decided with the observation that Police is going to file final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C and therefore, his grievance stands redressed. Learned counsel contends that the said report is still awaited and therefore, it has compelled him to file this petition. It is further argued that the private respondents are extending him threat.

To a pointed query, he submits that only some of the private respondents are on bail and he has not filed any application for cancellation of bail.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court does not find any reason to invoke inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C as alternatively, petitioner can approach the concerned Magistrate for redressal of his grievance in the light of the order dated 28.02.2019.

Petition is dismissed.
