Learned State counsel submits that the first claim of the petitioners with regard to grant of proficiency step up has been granted to them vide order dated 29.03.2017 (Annexure R-2). As regards the second claim, learned State counsel further states that the State has formulated a policy to regularize the persons who are in temporary employment and 251 vacancies have been reserved for them. As per the vacancy situation, employees upto seniority No.78 have been regularised. The petitioners fall at serial No.157 to 186. They will also be regularised as and when vacancies become available.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
