The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.109 dated 30.06.2019, under Sections 307, 324, 341, 506, 34, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 27 and 54 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Gharinda, District Amritsar.

It is stated in the petition that the petitioners, who are ladies, were not named in the FIR and have been arraigned as accused on the supplementary statement of the complainant which was recorded after 18 days of the incident.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that attack was planned and executed at the behest of the petitioners.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 30.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer and

join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Devender Pal, states that although the petitioners have joined investigation but they are not entitled to the concession of bail as the attack had been carried out at their behest. He also contends that the petitioners were arraigned as accused after ten days of the alleged incident as the statement of the complainant was recorded on 10.07.2019 while the incident took place on 30.06.2019.

In view of the afore-noted averments in the petition and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 30.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
