Petitioner Shashi Bala has appeared in person.

She has been heard.

Petitioner alleges that respondent no.5 was given one room on rent in the residential premises owned by her. Respondent no.5 claims himself to be a Baba. Further submits that respondent no.5 even though has left the premises but is instigating the son and daughter of the petitioner to cause bodily harm. Son and daughter of the petitioner have also been impleaded as respondents no.6 and 7 in the instant petition.

Petitioner alleges that she has been physically abused a number of times by respondents no.5 to 7 and she apprehends a threat to her life.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without verifying the submissions made by the petitioner in person in Court today, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent no.4 i.e. S.H.O., Police Station, Division No.2, Pathankot confined as regards the aspect of threat to her life.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, respondent no.4 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
