The petitioner is a resident of Village Lakho Majra, Tehsil Rajpura, District Patiala. He has a grievance that respondent No. 6 is unauthorizedly cutting the trees belonging to the Gram Panchayat. It is submitted that a complaint has been made to respondents No. 4 and 5 in this regard but no action has been taken so far.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and taking into consideration the averments made in the petition, we are of the considered opinion that the petitioner is basically asking for injunction for which he has the remedy under the civil law by filing a civil suit for permanent injunction against respondent No. 6 to restrain from cutting the trees of the Gram Panchayat. In view of thereof, there is hardly any merit in the writ petition to invoke the writ jurisdiction and the same is hereby dismissed as such.
