Petitioner-Jaskaran Singh has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 77 dated 29.06.2019, registered under Section 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Chhajali, District Sangrur. Petitioner is in custody w.e.f. 08.07.2019, the date of his arrest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the name of the petitioner is not mentioned in the FIR. According to him, on the complaint of Gurjant Singh (father of the deceased) this FIR was registered on the suspicion that his daughter-in-law Karamjit Kaur (co-accused) was having illicit relation with some person. According to the complainant, the deceased took extreme step and committed suicide in view of the conduct of his wife.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that investigation of the case is complete and challan has been filed on 2.9.2019.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel assisted by ASI Rajinder Kumar has opposed the prayer on the ground that name of the petitioner was given on 6.7.2019 in the supplementary statement by the complainant.

Considering the above and the fact that the trial is likely to consume some time, further detention of the petitioner may not be justified. Therefore, without meaning any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioner be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, Sangrur.

The petition is allowed.
