The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.70 dated 07.06.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

On 10.09.2019, this Court passed the following order:-

“Contentends that alleged agreement in question was executed way back on 15.02.2014 and the present FIR has been registered on 07.06.2019 i.e. after a period of more than 5 years.

Notice of motion for 16.10.2019.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of her arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit her to interim bail till the next date of hearing on her furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulbir, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated and she is not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 10.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to cooperate with learned trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed off.
