Vide this order, CRM-M-32250 of 2019 and CRM-M-32261 of 2019 shall stand disposed of.

Prayer in both the petitions is to grant regular bail to the petitioners in FIR No.19 dated 17.01.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 302, 392, 216, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the role of the

petitioners is similar to Sonu @ Badal and Deepak who were granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 30.05.2019 in CRM-M-23960 of 2019. The petitioners are also alleged to be co-conspirators with the aforesaid Sonu @ Badal and Deepak.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail (in both petitions) subject to furnishing of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed.
