The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.0046 dated 28.03.2019, under Sections 379B, 323 IPC (Sections 341, 325, 148, 149, 201 IPC added later on and Section 34 IPC deleted), registered at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are not named in the FIR wherein it is stated that a tab and a mobile phone of the complainant were snatched. He also contends that the identity of the petitioners is also doubtful. Petitioner No.1 is 20 years of age while petitioner No.2 is 22 years of age and they are in custody for over five months since their arrest on 10.04.2019. The petitioners are not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Baldev Singh, states that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners are not named in the FIR and they are in custody for over 05 months, they are not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
