On 30.07.2019, the following order was passed:

“Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.249, dated 06.07.2019, registered under Section 409 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari. It has been pleaded in the petition that the amount alleged to have been embezzled has already been deposited by the petitioner along with interest in November, 2017 while referring to Annexure P-4, a certificate issued by Sub Postmaster, Rewari. Further, reference has been made to Annexure P-2, an enquiry report dated 03.01.2019, in which it was concluded that no offence is found to have been committed.

Notice of motion for 13.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

In view of the above, the order dated 30.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall continue to cooperate with the trial Court and shall not seek any unnecessary adjournment.

The petition stands disposed of.
