The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.286 dated 27.09.2018, under Sections 302, 201, 120-B & 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, PGIMS Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused only on the basis that he was allegedly last seen with the deceased. He further contends that the complainant and other witnesses including the witnesses, who had last seen the petitioner with the deceased, have not supported the prosecution case qua the involvement of the petitioner. He is in custody since 27.12.2018. He is not involved in any other case. The similarly situated co-accused Sachin has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 18.07.2019 passed in CRM-M-29363-2019.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Karan Singh, is not in a position to controvert the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. He also contends that 09 out of 21 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is not involved in any other case and he is in custody for almost 10 months since 27.12.2018, similarly situated co-accused Sachin has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 18.07.2019 passed in CRM-M-29363-2019, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
