1. Prayer is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing impugned suspension order dated 7.1.2016 (Annexure P-10) as well as charge sheet dated 5.5.2016 (Annexure P-17) as also all proceedings arising out of the same.

2. None is present on behalf of the petitioner. Since the matter pertains to the year 2016, I am not inclined to adjourn the matter any further. Therefore, with the able assistance of learned DAG, I have gone over the paper book.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has referred to status report filed by Sh. Virender Singh, Joint Secretary to Govt. of Haryana Secondary Education Department, Panchkula that in view of the matter having been entrusted to the Inquiry Officer to inquire into the allegations against the petitioner, it had been decided by the competent Authority to reinstate the petitioner with immediate effect pending inquiry and in view thereof order of reinstatement of the petitioner (Annexure R-1) dated 8.2.2017 had been passed.

4. Learned DAG, Haryana, has also referred to short reply filed by Sh.Rajiv Prashad, Deputy Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Secondary Education Department, Haryana, Panchkula on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4 stating that pursuant to conduct of Inquiry, the petitioner has been found guilty of playing fraud upon the Government and has been awarded punishment of stoppage of one increment with cumulative effect vide Directorate Order No.4/725-2015 PGT-I (1) dated 26.10.2018 and that in the circumstances, the writ petition may be disposed of as not calling for any further orders.

5. In the light of the position as noted above, no further orders are called for. Writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner if so advised to challenge the order of punishment in accordance with law.
