AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court praying for quashing of the order dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab, whereby, stay order granted in favour of the petitioners in ROR No.614 of 2016 on 10.08.2016 (Annexure P-4) was vacated.

While issuing notice of motion on 15.12.2016, this Court had stayed the operation of the impugned order dated 02.12.2016 (Annexure P-5) and ordered the stay order dated 10.08.2016 (Annexure P-4) to continue.

Learned counsel for the contesting respondents No.3, 4 and 9 very fairly states that because of the pendency of the present writ petition, the matter is not being further processed by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) Punjab – respondent No.1. He contends that let the revision petition be ordered to be considered and decided keeping in view the fact that because of the stay granted in favour of the petitioners in this writ petition, process of finalization of the revision petition has been delayed.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the contesting respondents and keeping in view the prayer made in the writ petition, especially the interim order passed by this Court on 15.12.2016, this Court disposes of the present writ petition with the observation that the interim order dated 15.12.2016 shall continue to operate during the pendency of ROR No.614 of 2016, titled as 'Kamal Kaur & another Vs. Nirmal Kaur & others'.

Efforts be made by the Financial Commissioner (Revenue), Punjab, to decide the revision petition at the earliest keeping in view the fact that the matter has been pending in this Court for the last more than two years.
