Present application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for adding of offence under Sections 459, 325 and 201 IPC instead of Section 458 IPC in the main petition and to place on record amended petition.

In view of the grounds mentioned the application, same stands allowed. Amended petition is taken on record.

CRM-M-32422-2019

Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner—Azam Khan alias Bhollu in case F.I.R. No.64 dated 29.05.2019 under Sections 459, 325, 324, 148, 149, 506 and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that it is a case of version and cross version and there are injured on both the sides. Investigation in the case is already complete and challan has already been presented. The petitioner is in custody since 06.06.2019 and the trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage of the trial and taking into consideration the above facts and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 06.06.2019; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Azam Khan alias Bhollu, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
