Prayer in the instant petition is for quashing of impugned order dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P-15), whereby, the objections raised by the petitioner against his impugned reversion from the post of Junior Engineer to Work Munshi against Physically Handicapped quota, has been rejected.

At the very outset, learned State counsel has circulated a copy of order dated 26.02.2019 passed by respondent No.2, whereby, the petitioner has again been promoted to the post of Junior Engineer (Civil). A copy thereof is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the above factual position, however, states that the arrears of pay for the period of reversion have not been paid to him.

Heard.

In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner, if so advised, shall move a representation for the difference of salary and other benefits during the period of reversion. On moving such a representation, the same be considered by the competent authority within three months therefrom, in accordance with law. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
