This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to conduct enquiry against the Sarpanch of village Burj Pukhta on the basis of allegations contained in the applications made by the petitioner.

On the oral request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar is impleaded as respondent No.7. Registry is directed to amend the memo of parties accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to newly added respondent No.7-Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab, learned State counsel in the Court today.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.7-Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar to consider and decide the representation dated 26.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
