Petitioner seeks a Writ of Certiorari for quashing of the order dated 27.6.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by the S.D.M-cum-Registering and Licensing Authority, S.B.S Nagar, Nawanshehar and vide which a registration number PB-32R-0028 allotted to a Honda Amaze car has been canceled.

Counsel has been heard.

During the course of arguments it stands conceded that the number in question had been allotted at a point of time when the petitioner herein was the owner of the vehicle. It is the case of the petitioner himself that he had sold the vehicle along with registration number to respondent no.5 namely Manjit Singh son of Mahender Singh. Pursuant to such sale the vehicle along with the registration number had been duly transferred in the name of respondent no.5 in the records of the concerned Registering and Licensing Authority. Towards such effect even the registration certificate of the vehicle has been appended as Annexure P-1 and which reflects the owner of the car to be Manjit Singh and bearing registration no. PB-32R-0028.

Under such circumstances, counsel has not been able to demonstrate to this Court the locus of the petitioner to challenge the impugned order dated 27.6.2019 (Annexure P-8) when he is not even the owner of the vehicle.

Petition is dismissed.
