Learned counsel for the petitioners could not dispute the statement as has been recorded in the order dated 04.10.2019 passed by this Court, which reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for private respondents have brought to the notice of the Court that the petitioners have not only challenged the order dated 28.05.2018 (Annexure P-11) before this Court in the present writ petition but have also filed civil

suit as well as the revision petition before the Financial Commissioner. They, therefore, assert that the present writ petition would not be maintainable.

As the arguing counsel for the petitioners is not present, hearing of the case is deferred to 29.10.2019.

In the light of the above, the writ petition is dismissed as not maintainable.

Since the main writ petition stands dismissed, no orders are required to be passed on all the pending applications.

As the petitioners have already availed of their remedy in accordance with law but the same was not disclosed, cost of ₹50,000/- is imposed on them to be deposited with the Legal Services Authority of this Court within a period of four weeks from today. If the order passed by this Court is not complied with by the petitioners within the time stipulated, the case be again listed before this Court on **02.12.2019** for initiating further proceedings against the petitioners for non-compliance of the order.
