In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner was that the respondents were not reimbursing the medical bills, which the petitioner had submitted to the tune of ₹2,45,615/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the writ petition, the bills have been reimbursed and the amount has been released. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation claiming the interest on the said delayed payments.

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly states that in case any representation is received from the petitioner, the same will be

dealt in accordance with law and appropriate order will be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement, petitioner be given liberty to withdraw this petition for filing the representation.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
