Petitioner in this writ petition seeks a direction to the Haryana State authorities to treat him as equivalent to a State employee for the purpose of recruitment to the various posts notified under Advertisement No. 8 dated 20.2.2014 (Annexure P-2), published by the Haryana Public Service Commission, Panchkula.

Mr. H.N. Mehtani, learned counsel representing respondent No. 3, Haryana Public Service Commission, would state that the issue stands settled against the petitioner by the judgment dated 29.7.2019 of a Division Bench of this Court in ***CWP-19790-2019***, titled ***Deepak Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others***. Copy of the said judgment is placed on record. Perusal thereof reflects that the Division Bench held that the services of employees of statutory authorities could not be treated as equivalent to services rendered by Government employees in the various

In the light of the aforestated decision, no separate or independent adjudication is called for on merits in this case.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.
