Prayer made in the present writ petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.1 for deciding the complaint dated 20.11.2009 (Annexure P-1), filed by respondent No.2-Malkiat Singh, against the petitioner, within a time-bound manner. The same was on account of the pendency for the last 6 years and the fact that the petitioner had been deprived of the benefits of service including promotion.

A perusal of the reply filed by respondent No.1 would go on to show that the complaint was filed on 20.10.2015 (Annexure R-I) and the petitioner was informed vide communication dated 04.02.2016 (Annexure R-II). Resultantly, the present petition has become infructuous on account of the said fact and thus, the counsel for the petitioner has not put in appearance also on the last 2 occasions.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of, having been rendered infructuous.
