Prayer in the present petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 103 dated 8.7.2018 registered under Sections 341, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 302 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner was having a wooden baton and had hit shoulder of Nachhatar Singh and gave blow on the leg of Gursewak Singh. Both the injuries are simple in nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also relies upon the orders passed by this Court in Crl.Misc. No. M-20847 of 2019 (Gurwinder Singh @ Kalu vs. State of Punjab decided on 22.7.2019) and M-26560 of 2019 (Hissanpal vs. State of Punjab decided on 23.7.2019) with respect to the co-accused.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Sanjeev Kumar states that petitioner is in custody since 15.7.2018.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the facts that investigations are complete and the prosecution evidence

is being recorded and conclusion of trial is likely to take some time,

petitioner deserves the concession of bail and therefore, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
