The present revision is filed against the order dated 10.5.2019 vide which the application of respondent-Hardeep Kaur widow of Manpreet Singh alongwith her minor children was allowed and they were, accordingly, ordered to be impleaded as a party.

While praying for setting aside the said order, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that Hardeep Kaur is the widow of their third brother-Manpreet Singh, who has since died during the pendency of the suit.

The argument of learned counsel for the petitioners that respondent-Hardeep Kaur is not a necessary party deserves to be rejected in view of para No.3 of the revision petition wherein it is specifically mentioned that the shop in dispute came in the ownership of the petitioners alongwith their brother Manpreet Singh, who died on 11.8.2018. Thus, under these circumstances it is not understood as to how the widow of Manpreet Singh is not a necessary party.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to interfere in the impugned order.

The revision is dismissed accordingly.
