The prayer in the instant civil writ petition is to direct respondent No.2 to issue passport to the petitioner after adding the surname “Bajwa”.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner was deported from Brussels on strength of Emergency Certificate No. 874517 dated 23.01.2013 issued at Embassy of India, Brussels against his old Passport No. H-2419224 dated 23.12.2008. The petitioner while making application for fresh passport concealed this material fact. This fact was revealed on inquiry.

As the petitioner did not approach the authorities with clean hands, no relief can be allowed to him.

Dismissed.

However, if the petitioner re-submits his application with complete details, respondent No.2 shall take appropriate decision expeditiously as per law.
