Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to order dated 27.8.2019, the inspection was carried out and deficiencies as pointed out in letter dated 23.9.2019, were within the permissible limit and the same has been admitted by learned counsel for respondent No.2. However, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the deficiencies were to be removed by 31.12.2018. Since in the re-inspection/fresh inspection, the deficiencies have been removed and whatever the deficiencies are there, those deficiencies are within the relaxable limit.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner-College is at liberty for making admission in BAMS course for the academic session 2019-20.
