Petitioners sought a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 6.

In the petition it has been averred that the petitioners have entered into matrimony against the wishes of their elders and it is under such circumstances that they fear for their life and liberty.

Advance copy of the writ petition already stood served upon the State of Punjab.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar apprises the Court that petitioner no.1 has already suffered a statement and has even furnished a duly sworn affidavit stating therein that the marriage between the petitioners has since been accepted by the elders/relatives and that there is no apprehension of threat to their life and liberty.

In view of the above, no further directions are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
