ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 55 dated 02.04.2016, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 336 IPC added later on) and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that a shot was fired on the foot of the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted regular bail, but he could not appear before the Court, as he had wrongly noted the date of hearing and accordingly his bail was cancelled. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 12.09.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was to be released on ad-interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 16.09.2019 in terms of the previous order of this Court dated 12.09.2019 and he was released on ad-interim bail to its satisfaction.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 12.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court as and when called upon to do so. He shall not absent himself without the prior permission of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed of.
