HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. .

The grievance which is being raised by the petitioner in the present writ petition is that the persons junior to the petitioner were regularised in service w.e.f 1994, whereas, the service of the petitioner was regularised in 2003. Prayer of the petitioner is for regularisation of his service with effect from the date when service of his juniors/similarly situated persons was regularised.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that name of junior or similarly situated employee has not been mentioned by the petitioner so as to consider the claim of the petitioner for the grant of benefit of regularisation of his service from the said date. In the absence of any relevant amendment in the writ petition, no relief can be extended to the petitioner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays

that he be granted liberty to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation mentioning therein the name of the similarly situated/juniors of the petitioner, who have been granted the benefit of regularisation of their service w.e.f. 1994 i.e. prior to him.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that though, the prayer of the petitioner for regularisation of his service has already been declined, but, in case, any fresh document/fact is presented by the petitioner in the representation to be submitted now, the same will be considered and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of three months from the date of receipt of said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, he does not wish to press the present writ petition any further and same may be disposed of as having been not pressed.

Ordered accordingly.
