HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. .

In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.11.2012, but the benefit of gratuity and leave encashment has not been released to him so far. Unfortunately, during the pendency of the present writ petition, the petitioner has died and his legal representatives have been impleaded so as to continue with the present petition.

Counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief, which is being claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner had submitted representation dated 14.11.2014 (Annexure P/3) with the respondents raising his claims, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Counsel for the respondents states that they have no objection in

accepting the prayer of the petitioner for deciding the said representation in a time bound manner in case the same has not already been decided.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide representation dated 14.11.2014 (Annexure P/3) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case after the decision, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefit, the same shall also be released to him within a period of next three months. Respondents are also directed to convey the order so passed on the representation so as to enable the petitioner to have his legal remedy.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
