HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J.(ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner had sought voluntary retirement which request was accepted by the respondents and the petitioner was retired from service w.e.f. 01.07.2018. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that more than one year has elapsed but no pensionary benefits for the service, which the petitioner has rendered with the respondents, have been extended to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there are no proceedings pending against the petitioner either before the department or before any competent Court of law due to which the respondents are entitled to withhold the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a direction be issued to the respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-7) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and

the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 12.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
