On 01.08.2019, the following order was passed:-

“It has been pleaded in the petition that there is a delay of 14 days in lodging the present FIR as the incident had taken place on 11.05.2019, whereas the FIR was got registered on 22.05.2019.

Notice of motion for 12.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harvinder Pal Singh, has submitted that the petitioner in this case has already joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 01.08.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
