Through the instant writ petition, the petitioner seeks direction to respondent Nos. 4 & 5 to return the licenced revolver No. FG-21601-08 to the petitioner.

Admittedly, the weapon in question was deposited with respondent No.5 which as per the State was looted during the Jat Agitation in the year 2016. Considering the fact that entrustment is not denied, the respondents are directed to trace and return the weapon in question to the petitioner within three months and to renew the licence if there no other legal bar to hold the weapon in question by the petitioner. In case the State is unable to trace the weapon, it is directed to pay back the current market value to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
