The respondent issued an advertisement for recruitment to the posts of Panchayat Secretaries on 04.08.2016. Written examination was held on 02.10.2016. Petitioner cleared the written examination. As per the advertisement, he was to undergo type test for Punjabi as well as English. The petitioner passed the English type test but failed in Punjabi type test. He has raised certain pleas in the petition as regards the defect in the keyboard, which resulted in his failure.

Reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent. Learned State counsel at the outset submits that it is disputed question of fact which cannot be adjudicated upon in the writ jurisdiction. Besides, the petitioner typed 331 words in Punjabi, out of which the evaluating system mismatched 33 words and one word was missing. The contention of the petitioner was examined and it was found that there was no fault in the keyboard. The answer had been rightly evaluated by the system. Reference has been made to document (Annexure R-1) in this regard.

In view of above, no case for interference in writ jurisdiction is made out. The petition is without any merit and is hereby dismissed.
