This common order shall dispose of above noted three petitions.

Prayer in CRWP-664-2019, filed by Sai son of Mohd. Yousaf, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for releasing the alleged detenues namely Shema and Manna.

It is stated in this petition that the petitioner is the paternal uncle (*Taaya*) of the aforesaid detenues and they are living in illegal confinement of respondent No. 4 Gulam Ali and respondent No. 5 Seefo, who is the mother of the detenues.

Prayer in CRM-M-26646-2019, filed by Shema and Manna, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for providing protection to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 and 5, Gulam Ali and Seefo, respectively.

Prayer in the third petition i.e. CRM-M-31164-2019, filed by Mohd. Makkhan, Sai, Rehmdeen and Shafi, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is for providing protection to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent No. 7 Gulam Ali, who is allegedly extending threats to them on account of the custody of aforesaid two girls Shema and Manna.

In pursuance to the issuance of notice of motion, both the girls Shema and Manna are present in Court along with their mother Seefo, sister Sugi and *Taaya* Sai. The matter was taken in the pre-lunch session and the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for their counselling and recording of their statement in

this regard.

The matter has again taken up in post-lunch session and in the meantime, the parties appeared before the Mediator and their statements have been recorded.

In the statements of Shema, aged about 19 years, and Manna, aged about 16 years, it is stated that they have filed the above mentioned petition CRM-M-26646-2019 seeking protection to their life and liberty at the hands of their mother Seefo and Gulam Ali, however, now they have compromised the matter with each other and they are residing with their mother Seefo and do not want to pursue their petition. It is also stated that during the intervening period, they were staying with their sister with their paternal uncles Makkhan and Shafi along with their family. These statements are also signed by Seefo, mother of both the girls.

Therefore, in view of the above, these petitions are rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to Shema and Manna to stay with their mother Seefo as per their wish.
