This is second petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuing direction to respondent Nos.2 to 6 to conduct investigation in a fair and impartial manner.

It is undisputed that the previous petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of by a coordinate Bench in the following terms on 27.04.2018:-

“The petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Mewat to look into the grievances of the petitioner as contained in the representation and if he comes to the conclusion that taking of some action in the matter is called for then the needful be done within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.”

Since, the directions have already been issued, therefore, second petition would not be maintainable. It is further not in dispute that the

petitioner has filed a petition for initiating the proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act for non-compliance of directions issued in the order dated 27.04.2018, which has been extracted above.

Hence, second petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
