On 01.08.2019, the following order was passed:

“Notice of motion for 24.09.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-31771-2019.”

On 24.09.2019, at the request of learned counsel for the State, petitioner was again directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from H.C. Saroop Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.
