CWP-21310-2018

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to register the sale deed dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P-2) and to act upon representation dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P-10).

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Deputy

Commissioner-cum-Registrar, Kapurthala to consider and decide the application/representation dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P-10).

Learned State counsel submits that he is not averse to the suggestion put forth by learned Senior counsel.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 Deputy Commissioner-cum-Registrar, Kapurthala to consider and decide the representation dated 26.07.2018 (Annexure P-10) in accordance with law, within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
