Learned counsel for the petitioner in the light of the objections taken in reply by contesting respondents, prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition with liberty to avail of the alternative remedy before the Financial Commissioner.

Dismissed as withdraw with liberty aforesaid.

In case an application for condonation of delay is filed, the Financial Commissioner, may look into the same keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had approached this Court and the writ petition having been pending since 2015.

Liberty is granted to private respondents to object on the question of limitation as it is asserted that "Sanad Taxim" had been issued on 04.02.2013.
