Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.88 dated 19.04.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Kapurthala.

This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 06.09.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties have amicably settled the dispute and even otherwise the injuries attributed in the present case are simple in nature.

Learned State counsel has also conceded the factum of injury and he wishes to verify the compromise between the parties.

Adjourned to 15.11.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim

bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Contentends that in terms of above order, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Paramjit, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 06.09.2019, petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 06.09.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioner shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
