This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for quashing the impugned notice/order dated 11.6.2018 (Annexure P-8), vide which it has been ordered that the parking fee of the vehicles shall be charged at the entry gate of the Subzi Mandi, Banga, instead of charging the parking fee from the space where the vehicles are parked.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the period of
