Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as counsel for respondents 4 and 5, who has filed a caveat, state that a compromise has been entered into between the parties and according to the said compromise, the watercourse which was exclusively sanctioned for use of respondents 4 and 5 has now been decided to be kept joint. Bhupinder Singh-petitioner No.1 is present in Court and states that a compromise has indeed been entered into between the parties on 23.08.2019. Copy of the compromise entered into between the parties has been placed on record.

In the light of the said document, which has been placed on record and marked as 'A', which has been acknowledged by the counsel for the parties to be the copy of the compromise, the present writ petition is disposed of in the light of the compromise dated 23.08.2019.

The parties will approach the competent authority/ Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Ludhiana, for incorporation of the said compromise in the records and to amend the relevant partition records as well.
