Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to release him pre-maturely forthwith on usual terms and conditions in terms of Govt. Instructions dated 08.07.1991 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that case of the petitioner was kept in abeyance only on the ground that the report from the District Magistrate, Ittawa (Uttar Pradesh) was not received.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to consider the claim of

the petitioner with regard to pre-mature release as per policy dated 08.07.1991 (Annexure P-1) within a period of 90 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
